I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No. F.5-180/86-UT.I dated the 12th August, 1987, on the above subject and to say that in regard to implementation of the revised pay scales of school teachers indicated in the above referred letter contains many referred letter. indicated in the above referred letter, certain point as mentioned below have been raised. The matter has been considered in consultation with the Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) and the following clarifications are issued:

For fixing the pay and determining the pay scale for such teachers, their of service in respect of those service in the present grade will be counted from the date of promotion as per normal practice. However, the pay of any such teacher will be so fixed as to be at a stage not lower than the pay of his ersthile junior in the cadre from which he has been promoted to the present post.

Persons who get promoted from senior s fixation of pay in the case of scale will get fixed in the basic scale of the higher grade. But the persons already in the selection scale cannot be fixed in the basic scale of the higher post because the latter is lower than the former. Therefore, those in the selection scale will be fixed in the senior scale of the next higher grade on promotion and pay fixed in that scale.

Since the teacher already in the selection scale of the lower grade higher than the pay scale for I will not be fixed in the basic scale the lower post, and therefore, of the promotion/post, but to a I senior scale (as per clarification at No. 6 above) which is not a promotional it scale for them, the benefit under FR 22-C will not be available. 10. The Headmasters of primary schools are equated with the trained graduate teachers and headmasters of middle schools with post graduate teachers . It is therefore, to be clari fied as to whether these headmasters will be required to acquire the same educational qualifications.

It would be necessary for these pheadmasters to have the same academic qualifications as are required for I the teaching post with which they are equated.
